After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

<u>HB24-1039</u> be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and 2 substitute: "SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-2-117, amend 3 4 (1)(b)(IX) and (1)(b)(X); and add (1)(b)(XI) and (7) as follows: 5 22-2-117. Additional power - state board - waiver of 6 requirements - rules - definitions. (1) (b) The state board shall not 7 waive any of the requirements specified in any of the following statutory 8 provisions: 9 Any provisions of section 22-1-128 relating to (IX) 10 comprehensive human sexuality education content requirements; or (X) Any provision of section 22-30.5-104 (3), 22-30.5-507 (3), 11 12 22-32-109 (1)(11), 22-32-110 (1)(k), 22-38-104 (1)(d), or 22-63-206 (1) 13 relating to discrimination based on hair texture, hair type, or a protective hairstyle that is commonly or historically associated with race; OR 14 15 (XI) ANY PROVISION OF SECTION 22-32-109 (1)(11), 22-32-110 16 (1)(k), 22-38-104 (1)(d), OR 22-63-206 (1) RELATING TO DISCRIMINATION 17 BASED ON GENDER EXPRESSION THROUGH THE USE OF A CHOSEN NAME. 18 (7) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, UNLESS THE CONTEXT OTHERWISE 19 **REQUIRES:** 20 (a) "CHOSEN NAME" MEANS ANY NAME THAT AN INDIVIDUAL 21 REQUESTS TO BE KNOWN AS, OTHER THAN THE INDIVIDUAL'S LEGAL NAME, 22 TO REFLECT THAT INDIVIDUAL'S GENDER IDENTITY. (b) "GENDER EXPRESSION" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL'S WAY OF 23 24 REFLECTING AND EXPRESSING THE INDIVIDUAL'S GENDER TO THE OUTSIDE 25 WORLD, TYPICALLY DEMONSTRATED THROUGH APPEARANCE, DRESS, AND 26 BEHAVIOR, OR USE OF A CHOSEN NAME. 27 SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-32-109, amend 28 (1)(11)(11) as follows:

22-38-104. Pilot schools - requirements - authority definitions. (1) The state board may provide for the establishment and
 operation of not more than one full-time residential pilot school and not
 more than three year-round nonresidential pilot schools pursuant to the
 following provisions:

(d) (II) As used in this subsection (1)(d):
 (A) "CHOSEN NAME" MEANS ANY NAME THAT AN INDIVIDUAL
 REQUESTS TO BE KNOWN AS, OTHER THAN THE INDIVIDUAL'S LEGAL NAME,

4 TO REFLECT THAT INDIVIDUAL'S GENDER IDENTITY.

21 (II) "GENDER EXPRESSION" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL'S WAY OF
22 REFLECTING AND EXPRESSING THE INDIVIDUAL'S GENDER TO THE OUTSIDE
23 WORLD, TYPICALLY DEMONSTRATED THROUGH APPEARANCE, DRESS, AND
24 BEHAVIOR, OR USE OF A CHOSEN NAME.

(I) (III) "Protective hairstyle" includes such hairstyles as braids,
locs, twists, tight coils or curls, cornrows, Bantu knots, Afros, and
headwraps.

28 (II) (IV) "Race" includes hair texture, hair type, or a protective
 29 hairstyle that is commonly or historically associated with race.

30 SECTION 6. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-34-301, amend
31 (9); and add (3.5) as follows:

32 24-34-301. Definitions. As used in parts 3 to 10 of this article 34,
33 unless the context otherwise requires:

34 (3.5) "CHOSEN NAME" MEANS ANY NAME THAT AN INDIVIDUAL
35 REQUESTS TO BE KNOWN AS, OTHER THAN THE INDIVIDUAL'S LEGAL NAME,
36 TO REFLECT THAT INDIVIDUAL'S GENDER IDENTITY.

(9) "Gender expression" means an individual's way of reflecting
and expressing the individual's gender to the outside world, typically
demonstrated through appearance, dress, and behavior, OR USE OF A
CHOSEN NAME.

41 SECTION 7. Safety clause. The general assembly finds,
42 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
43 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for

- 2 institutions.".
