After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB24-1075 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 6, strike lines 16 through 18 and substitute:

2 "(g) DESCRIBE INCENTIVES AND FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS FOR
3 HOSPITALS FROM A GLOBAL BUDGETING BASED REIMBURSEMENT SYSTEM
4 COMPARED TO A FEE-FOR-SERVICE BASED REIMBURSEMENT SYSTEM;"

5 Page 7, after line 22 insert:

6 "(m) ESTIMATE THE IMPACT OF IMPLEMENTING A UNIVERSAL
7 HEALTH-CARE SYSTEM ON HEALTH PLANS THAT ARE REGULATED BY THE
8 FEDERAL "EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT INCOME SECURITY ACT OF 1974", 29
9 U.S.C. SEC. 1001 ET SEQ., AS AMENDED, INCLUDING MULTIEMPLOYER
10 TAFT-HARTLEY HEALTH-CARE TRUST FUNDS;

11 (n) EVALUATE THE FEASIBILITY OF IMPLEMENTING A UNIVERSAL
12 HEALTH-CARE SYSTEM BY EXPANDING OR MODIFYING THE COLORADO
13 OPTION HEALTH INSURANCE PLAN;"

14 Reletter succeeding paragraphs accordingly.

15 Page 8, after line 2 insert:

16 "(5) THE COLORADO SCHOOL OF PUBLIC HEALTH MAY UTILIZE AN
17 ACTUARIAL CONSULTANT IN CONDUCTING THE ANALYSIS PURSUANT TO
18 SUBSECTION (4) OF THIS SECTION."

19 Renumber succeeding subsections accordingly.

20 Page 9, strike line 9 and substitute:

1 "(III) ONE MEMBER WHO REPRESENTS AN ORGANIZATION THAT
2 ADVOCATES FOR COMMUNITIES WITH DISABILITIES;".

3 Page 10, line 8, strike "AND".

4 Page 10, strike line 10 and substitute "INTERESTS;

5 (XVIII) ONE MEMBER WHO REPRESENTS A PHARMACY BENEFIT
6 MANAGEMENT FIRM, AS DEFINED IN SECTION 10-16-102 (49);

7 (XIV) ONE MEMBER WHO REPRESENTS A SELF-INSURED EMPLOYER
8 THAT PROVIDES HEALTH INSURANCE TO ITS EMPLOYEES UNDER A HEALTH
9 INSURANCE PLAN COVERED BY THE FEDERAL "EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT
10 INCOME SECURITY ACT OF 1974", 29 U.S.C. SEC. 1001 ET SEQ., AS
11 AMENDED; AND

12 (XV) ONE MEMBER WHO REPRESENTS MANAGEMENT OF
13 ORGANIZED LABOR THAT PROVIDES HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR
14 INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE INSURED UNDER A HEALTH INSURANCE PLAN
15 COVERED BY THE FEDERAL "EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT INCOME SECURITY
16 ACT OF 1974", 29 U.S.C. SEC. 1001 ET SEQ., AS AMENDED."

17 Page 11, line 15, strike "SIX" and substitute "FOUR".

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
