After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB24-1089 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 5, strike lines 18 through 26 and substitute:

2 "SECTION 5. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-1-234, amend
3 (1)(a) introductory portion, (1)(b), (1)(c), (2)(a) introductory portion,
4 (2)(b)(I)(A), and (2)(b)(I)(B) as follows:

5 **42-1-234. Electronic vehicle registration and titling - electronic**
6 **transmission of vehicle lien information - authority - rules - electronic**
7 **transactions fund - gifts, grants, and donations - repeal.** (1) (a) ON OR
8 BEFORE SEPTEMBER 30, 2024, the department ~~may~~ SHALL establish a
9 system to allow the electronic transmission of registration, lien, and titling
10 information for motor vehicles, ~~off-highway vehicles, or special mobile~~
11 ~~machinery~~ INCLUDING FOR LEASED MOTOR VEHICLES. Except as provided
12 in subsection (3) of this section, the department may adopt rules necessary
13 for the implementation of this section, including rules to allow the
14 department to:

15 (1) (b) The department's approval of a third-party provider to
16 register a vehicle, ~~or special mobile machinery~~, file or release liens, or
17 issue any type of certificate of title must be evidenced by an agreement
18 between the department and the third-party provider.

19 (c) In registering a vehicle, ~~or special mobile machinery~~, filing or
20 releasing liens, or issuing any type of certificate of title, the third-party
21 provider is acting as an agent of the department. The third-party provider
22 shall collect and remit to the department all taxes and fees imposed by
23 law to issue any type of certificate of title, TO file or release a lien, or to
24 register the vehicle. ~~or special mobile machinery~~.

25 (2) (a) The department is authorized to seek and accept gifts,
26 grants, or donations from private or public sources, including from
27 third-party providers, for the purposes of this section; except that the
28 department may not accept a gift, grant, or donation that is subject to

1 conditions that are inconsistent with this section or any other law of the
2 state. The department shall ensure that any funds contributed to the
3 department for the implementation of the system for the electronic
4 transmission of registration, lien, and titling information for motor
5 vehicles AND vehicles ~~off-highway vehicles, and special mobile~~
6 ~~machinery~~ are:

7 (b) (I) In addition to the fees described in subsection (1)(c) of this
8 section, a third-party provider shall pay the department a fee of up to
9 three dollars for each of the following types of transactions completed by
10 the third-party provider:

11 (A) Issuance of or transfer of a certificate of title for a motor
12 vehicle; ~~or an off-highway vehicle;~~

13 (B) Issuance of or renewal of a registration for a motor vehicle OR
14 a vehicle; ~~or special mobile machinery;~~ and

15 **SECTION 6. Safety clause.** The general assembly finds,
16 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
17 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for
18 the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state
19 institutions."

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
