After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB24-1103 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 2, line 18, strike "SYMPTOMOLOGY" and
2 substitute "SYMPTOMATOLOGY".

3 Page 4, line 24, after the period add "NOTHING IN THIS SECTION PROHIBITS
4 THE INSTRUCTION OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE COURSES THAT
5 INCLUDE THE SAFE AND EFFECTIVE MEDICAL INTERACTION WITH
6 INDIVIDUALS EXHIBITING AN ALTERED MENTAL STATE, INCLUDING
7 SYMPTOMATOLOGY OF A STATE OF AGITATION, EXCITABILITY, PARANOIA,
8 EXTREME AGGRESSION, PHYSICAL VIOLENCE, AND APPARENT IMMUNITY
9 FROM PAIN."
