<u>HB24-1135</u> be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on <u>Finance</u> with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 3, strike lines 17 through 27.
- 2 Strike pages 4 through 11.
- 3 Page 12, strike lines 1 through 14 and substitute:
- 4 "SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 43-2-145, add (2.1)
 5 as follows:

6 43-2-145. Transportation legislation review - committee 7 definition - repeal. (2.1) (a) DURING THE 2024 LEGISLATIVE INTERIM,
8 THE COMMITTEE SHALL ANALYZE THE ISSUE OF ENFORCEMENT OF
9 IMPAIRED DRIVING OFFENSES, INCLUDING SITUATIONS INVOLVING A
10 DRIVER WHO REFUSES TO TAKE OR COMPLETE A BLOOD OR BREATH TEST
11 AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

(b) THE COMMITTEE MAY REQUEST AND RECEIVE INPUT FROM THE
COLORADO STATE PATROL AND THE COLORADO TASK FORCE ON DRUNK
AND IMPAIRED DRIVING CREATED IN SECTION 42-4-1306 AND TAKE
TESTIMONY FROM INTERESTED OR KNOWLEDGEABLE PEOPLE ABOUT THE
ISSUE OF ENFORCEMENT OF IMPAIRED DRIVING OFFENSES AND MAY
OTHERWISE RESEARCH THE ISSUE.

(c) THE COMMITTEE MAY MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS CONCERNING
THE ISSUE OF ENFORCEMENT OF IMPAIRED DRIVING OFFENSES DESCRIBED
IN THIS SUBSECTION (2.1) TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, AND, IF THE
COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS LEGISLATION, THE LEGISLATION IS TREATED AS
LEGISLATION RECOMMENDED BY AN INTERIM LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE
FOR PURPOSES OF ANY INTRODUCTION DEADLINES OR BILL LIMITATIONS
IMPOSED BY THE JOINT RULES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

25 (d) This subsection (2.1) is repealed, effective July 1, 2025.".
