Page 5, line 12, strike "(a.5) A PERSON SHALL NOT" and substitute 24 "(a) Regardless of whether a person displays an identifying plate or 25 26 placard, a person shall not park a vehicle so as to block reasonable access 27 to curb ramps, passenger loading zones, ACCESS AISLES, or accessible 28 routes, as those terms are defined in the 2010 ADA Standards for 29 ACCESSIBLE DESIGN identified in 28 CFR part 36 appendix A, that are 30 clearly identified unless the person is actively loading or unloading a 31 person with a disability.

8 Page 5, line 19, strike "SECTION, THE PEACE OFFICER" and substitute 9 "SECTION".
