"SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-30-111, amend (4)(a)(IV) and (4)(a)(V); and add (4)(a)(VI) as follows: 12-30-111. Electronic prescribing of controlled substances exceptions - rules - definitions. (4) As used in this section: (a) "Prescriber" means: (IV) An optometrist licensed pursuant to article 275 of this title 12; or (V) A podiatrist licensed pursuant to article 290 of this title 12; OR (VI) A NATUROPATHIC DOCTOR REGISTERED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 250 OF THIS TITLE 12.".
Renumbering succeeding sections accordingly.
Page 2, line 7, after "medicines" insert "AND DEVICES".
Page 2, line 9, after "prescription" insert "AND NONPRESCRIPTION".
Page 3, line 2, strike "UPDATES" and substitute "REVISIONS".

- 30 "SECTION 6. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-250-107, amend
- 31 (2)(d); and **add** (2)(d.5) as follows:
- 32 12-250-107. Registration required qualifications -
- 33 examination registration by endorsement rules. (2) An applicant

for a registration to practice as a naturopathic doctor in this state shall submit an application to the director in a form and manner determined by the director by rule, accompanied by the fee required pursuant to section 12-20-105. The director shall issue a registration to practice as a naturopathic doctor to an applicant upon receipt of satisfactory proof that the applicant:

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- (d) Has successfully passed either a director-approved examination or a comprehensive competency-based national naturopathic licensing examination administered by the North American Board of Naturopathic Examiners or a nationally recognized, director-approved successor entity, as determined by the director by rule; and
- (d.5) Beginning September 1, 2024, has successfully passed a pharmacology examination administered by the North American Board of Naturopathic Examiners or a nationally recognized, director-approved successor entity, as determined by the director by rule; and

SECTION 7. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-250-109, **amend** (1)(b)(II) and (1)(b)(III); and **add** (1)(b)(IV) as follows:

- 12-250-109. Continuing professional competency rules. (1) (b) The director shall adopt rules establishing a continuing professional competency program that includes, at a minimum, the following elements:
- (II) Development, execution, and documentation of a learning plan based on the assessment; and
- (III) Periodic demonstration of knowledge and skills through documentation of activities necessary to ensure continuing competency in the profession; except that a naturopathic doctor need not retake any examination required by section 12-250-107 (2)(d) for initial registration; AND
- (IV) FOR REGISTRATION RENEWAL ON OR AFTER JUNE 1, 2025, TEN
 HOURS PER YEAR OF EDUCATION IN PHARMACOLOGY. THE DIRECTOR
 SHALL NOT INCREASE THE TOTAL NUMBER OF HOURS OF CONTINUING
 PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCY THAT A NATUROPATHIC DOCTOR MUST
 COMPLETE PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION.".
 - Page 4, strike lines 15 through 23 and substitute:
- 36 "SECTION 8. Act subject to petition effective date. This act 37 takes effect September 1, 2024; except that, if a referendum petition is 38 filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against 39 this act or an item, section, or part of this act within the ninety-day period 40 after final adjournment of the general assembly, then the act, item, 41 section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the

- 1 general election to be held in November 2024 and, in such case, will take
- 2 effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the
- 3 governor.".

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
