THE 25 DEPARTMENT OR ORGANIZATION CONDUCTING THE STUDY MAY COLLECT 26 THIS FEEDBACK THROUGH MULTIPLE MEANS, INCLUDING ONLINE OR 27 IN-PERSON SURVEYS OR PUBLIC FEEDBACK SESSIONS.
