After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:
HB24-1307 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:
Amend printed bill, page 19, line 16, strike "DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL AFFAIRS;" and substitute "GOVERNOR'S OFFICE;".
Page 22, strike lines 14 through 20 and substitute:  "SECTION 7. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-75-232, amend (1)(d) and (2)(d); and add (1)(d.5) and (5)(e) as follows:  24-75-232. "Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act" cash fund - creation - allowable uses - report - legislative declaration - definitions - repeal. (1) The general assembly finds and declares that:  (d) In order for the state to be competitive for the highest range of funding available to it under the federal act, it is necessary for departments to have funds available as a nonfederal match, although due to still-evolving federal guidance the amounts needed and specific types of projects may not be known in time for this money to be appropriated in the annual general appropriation act; and  (d.5) WITH THE PASSAGE OF THE "INFLATION REDUCTION ACT OF 2022" AND THE "BIPARTISAN INFRASTRUCTURE LAW" BILLIONS OF
DOLLARS IN FEDERAL MONEY ARE AVAILABLE TO HELP PUBLIC SCHOOL
IMPROVE AIR QUALITY IN SCHOOLS, STUDENT PERFORMANCE, AND STAFF
RETENTION; AND  (2) As used in this section unless the context otherwise requires.

Page 22, strike lines 24 and 25 and substitute:

"(II) THE OFFICE SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE JOINT BUDGET COMMITTEE AND THE CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE CONCERNING THE NUMBER OF APPLICANTS FOR MATCHING FUNDS FROM SCHOOL DISTRICTS REVIEWED BY THE OFFICE BEFORE OCTOBER 2, 2025. THE REPORT MUST INCLUDE THE AMOUNT OF REQUESTED MATCHING FUNDS, THE RECOMMENDED AMOUNT OF MATCHING FUNDS, AND AN EXPLANATION FOR THE DIFFERENCE, IF ANY, BETWEEN THE REQUESTED AMOUNTS AND THE RECOMMENDED AMOUNTS.

(III) FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION (5)(e), THE OFFICE MAY USE EXISTING MONEY APPROPRIATED FROM THE FUND TO PROVIDE GRANT WRITING SUPPORT, ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT, AND PROJECT PLANNING PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (1)(e)(V) OF THIS SECTION TO REVIEW THE WORK OF APPLICANTS AND TO CONNECT APPLICANTS WITH THIRD PARTIES WITH EXPERTISE PERTAINING TO".

Page 23, after line 18 insert:

17 "(IV) IF THERE ARE APPROVED APPLICATIONS FOR HVAC
18 INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AT SCHOOL PROJECTS AS
19 DESCRIBED IN SECTION 22-32-152, THE OFFICE MAY SEEK A
20 SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FROM THE FUND.".
