- 1 Amend printed bill, page 7, line 24, strike "MAY" and substitute "SHALL".
- 2 Page 12, after line 17 insert:

SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION, BY DECEMBER 31 OF THE LAST
CALENDAR YEAR DURING WHICH CREDITS WERE ALLOCATED BY THE
