After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:
HB24-1329 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:
Amend printed bill, page 3, strike line 25 and substitute "(1)(c) introductory portion, (2)(b), and (3)(a); <b>repeal</b> (1)(c)(III); and <b>add</b> (3)(c) as follows:".
Page 4, after line 15 insert:
"(3) <b>Board powers and duties regarding professional land surveyors.</b> For purposes of administering part 3 of this article 120 pertaining to the regulation of professional land surveyors, the board shall:
(a) Require each applicant for professional land surveyor licensing to demonstrate competence by means of examination and education and may require work examples as it deems necessary and sufficient for licensing. and
(c) PROMULGATE RULES TO ESTABLISH CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS FOR PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYORS AS A CONDITION OF LICENSE RENEWAL.".
Page 9, strike lines 20 through 27.
Page 10, strike lines 1 and 2.
Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
Page 10, line 22, after "program." insert "AN APPLICANT FOR LICENSURE BY ENDORSEMENT MUST HOLD A LICENSE IN GOOD STANDING IN A

JURISDICTION THAT REQUIRES QUALIFICATIONS THAT ARE SUBSTANTIALLY

EQUIVALENT TO THE REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSURE SET FORTH IN

- 1 SUBSECTIONS (1) AND (2) OF THIS SECTION. AN APPLICANT FOR LICENSURE
- 2 BY ENDORSEMENT SHALL SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE BOARD IN A
- 3 FORM AND MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE BOARD.".

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
