Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB24-1349 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend the Finance Committee Report, dated April 1, 2024, page 6, line
2 31, after "(4)" strike "(a)".

3 Page 7 of the report, line 4, strike "(I)" and substitute "(a)".

4 Page 7 of the report, line 5, strike "(II)" and substitute "(b)".

5 Page 8 of the report, line 1, strike "line 24, strike "39-37-109 (2)" and
6 substitute "39-37-110 (2)." and substitute "strike lines 23 through 26 and
7 substitute:

8 "(b) SUBJECT TO ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BY THE GENERAL
9 ASSEMBLY, FOR STATE FISCAL YEAR 2024-25 AND ANY STATE FISCAL YEAR
10 THEREAFTER, THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE MAY EXPEND MONEY FROM
11 THE FUND FOR DIRECT AND INDIRECT COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH
12 IMPLEMENTING AND ADMINISTERING THIS ARTICLE 37.

13 (3) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS SECTION,
14 ON JUNE 30, 2025 AND JUNE 30, 2026, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL
15 TRANSFER FROM THE FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND AN AMOUNT OF MONEY
16 EQUAL TO THE AMOUNT OF MONEY USED IN THE STATE FISCAL YEARS
17 2024-25 AND 2025-26, FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO PAY THE COSTS OF
18 IMPLEMENTING AND ADMINISTERING THIS ARTICLE 37."."

19 Page 15 of the report, line 13, strike "TITLE 39." and substitute "TITLE
20 39.

21 **SECTION 17. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2024-25 state fiscal
22 year, \$383,027 is appropriated to the department of revenue. This
23 appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the
24 department may use this appropriation as follows:

- 1 (a) \$26,810 for use by the executive director's office for personal
2 services related to administration and support;
- 3 (b) \$139,050 for tax administration IT system (GenTax) support;
- 4 (c) \$40,493 for use by the taxation business group for personal
5 services related to taxation services, which amount is based on an
6 assumption that the group will require an additional 0.4 FTE;
- 7 (d) \$3,847 for use by the taxation business group for operating
8 expenses related to taxation services; and
- 9 (e) \$172,827 for the purchase of legal services.
- 10 (2) For the 2024-25 state fiscal year, \$172,827 is appropriated to
11 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds
12 received from the department of revenue under subsection (1)(e) of this
13 section and is based on an assumption that the department of law will
14 require an additional 0.8 FTE. To implement this act, the department of
15 law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for the
16 department of revenue.
- 17 (3) The money appropriated by this section becomes available
18 upon passage of the ballot measure pursuant to Section 39-37-201, (2)
19 C.R.S."."

21 "Page 19 of the printed bill, line 3, strike "takes" and substitute
22 "and section 24-33.5-1811, Colorado Revised Statutes, amended in
23 section 3 of this act, take"."

26 substitute "AMMUNITION,"."

27 Page 15 of the report, line 30, strike "CRIMES."." and substitute "CRIMES,
28 AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION."."

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
