3 4 5 7 8 9 9 1 1 2 3 4	"(2) Kinship foster care homes are eligible for financial reimbursement and supports at the same rate as foster care homes, as established in rules promulgated by the state board of human services. Non-certified kinship care homes are eligible for financial assistance and supports at thirty percent of the foster care rate, based on the age of the child or youth receiving care. Beginning in state fiscal year 2026-27, non-certified kinship care homes are eligible for financial assistance and support at fifty percent of the foster care rate, based on the age of the child or youth receiving care. Funding to cover financial assistance and supports comes from the revenue stream identified in subsection (3) of this section.".
