Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB24-095 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Strike the Finance Committee Report, dated April 30, 2024.
- 2 Amend the Transportation and Energy Committee Report, dated April 26,
3 2024, page 3, strike lines 17 through 24.
- 4 Amend printed bill, page 11, line 6, strike "EIGHTY" and substitute
5 "FIFTY".
- 6 Page 11, strike lines 17 through 27 and substitute:

7 **"25-7-147. Photochemical modeling required for state**
8 **implementation plan - repeal.** (1) THE COMMISSION AND DIVISION
9 SHALL USE PHOTOCHEMICAL MODELING AND DATA ANALYSIS AS THE BASIS
10 FOR REVISING THE STATE IMPLEMENTATION PLAN IN 2026. THE
11 PHOTOCHEMICAL MODELING MUST CONFORM WITH THE COMPREHENSIVE
12 AIR QUALITY MODELING SYSTEM WITH EXTENSION.
13 (2) THE COMMISSION AND DIVISION SHALL IMPLEMENT THIS
14 SECTION BY CONTRACTING WITH A RESEARCH INSTITUTION TO CONDUCT
15 THE PHOTOCHEMICAL MODELING AND DATA ANALYSIS.
16 (3) THIS SECTION IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2027."
- 17 Page 12 of the bill, strike lines 1 through 22.
- 18 Amend printed bill, page 12, before line 23, insert:

19 **"SECTION 8. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2024-25 state fiscal
20 year, \$100,000 is appropriated to the department of public health and
21 environment for use by the air pollution control division. This

1 appropriation is from the nonattainment area air pollution mitigation
2 enterprise fund created in section 43-4-1303 (5)(a), C.R.S. To implement
3 this act, the division may use this appropriation for program costs related
4 to administration.

5 (2) For the 2024-25 state fiscal year, \$15,897 is appropriated to
6 the department of revenue. This appropriation is from the nonattainment
7 area air pollution mitigation enterprise fund created in section 43-4-1303
8 (5)(a), C.R.S. To implement this act, the department may use this
9 appropriation as follows:

10 (a) \$13,022 for use by the division of motor vehicles for personal
11 services related to vehicle services, which amount is based on an
12 assumption that the division will require an additional 0.3 FTE;

13 (b) \$1,984 for use by the division of motor vehicles for DRIVES
14 maintenance and support;

15 (c) \$384 for division of motor vehicles for operating expenses
16 related to vehicle services; and

17 (d) \$210 for the executive director's office for personal services
18 related to administration and support; and

19 (e) \$297 for the purchase of information technology services.

20 (3) For the 2024-25 state fiscal year, \$297 is appropriated to the
21 office of the governor for use by the office of information technology.
22 This appropriation is from reappropriated funds received from the
23 department of revenue under subsection (2)(e) of this section. To
24 implement this act, the office may use this appropriation to provide
25 information technology services for the department of revenue."

26 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

27 Amend the Transportation and Energy Committee Report, dated April 26,
28 2024, page 5, line 14, strike "**equipment and**" and substitute
29 "**equipment**".

30 Page 5 of the report, line 15, strike "**analysis**." and substitute "**analysis,**
31 **and making an appropriation**.".

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
