After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

- <u>SB24-162</u> be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:
- 1 Amend printed bill, page 6, after line 9 insert:

"(i) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS AND DECLARES THAT FOR THE
PURPOSES OF SECTION 17 OF ARTICLE IX OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION,
DEVELOPING BEST PRACTICES TO EFFECTIVELY RESPOND TO REPORTS OF
HARASSMENT OR DISCRIMINATION, AS DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION (8),
IMPROVES STUDENT SAFETY AND MAY THEREFORE RECEIVE FUNDING FROM
THE STATE EDUCATION FUND CREATED IN SECTION 17 (4) OF ARTICLE IX
OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION.

9 (j) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT USE MORE THAN TEN PERCENT OF 10 THE MONEY APPROPRIATED TO DEVELOP BEST PRACTICES TO EFFECTIVELY 11 RESPOND TO REPORTS OF HARASSMENT OR DISCRIMINATION, AS DESCRIBED 12 IN THIS SUBSECTION (8), FOR THE ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS INCURRED 13 RELATED TO DEVELOPING THE BEST PRACTICES.".

14 Amend printed bill, page 6, after line 17 insert:

15 "SECTION 3. Appropriation. For the 2024-25 state fiscal year, 16 \$111,111 is appropriated to the department of education for use by 17 management and administration. This appropriation is from the state 18 education fund created in section 17 (4) of article IX of the state 19 constitution. To implement this act, the department may use this 20 appropriation for training for local education providers on responding to 17 harassment and discrimination reports.".

22 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

Page 1, line 103, strike "PRACTICES." and substitute "PRACTICES AND
MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.".
