After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB25-1027 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 8, line 22, strike "**information - rules - repeal.**"  
2 and substitute "**information.**".

3 Page 9, strike lines 13 through 27.

4 Page 10, strike lines 1 through 22 and substitute:

5           "(2) If the student's certificate of immunization is not up to date  
6 according to the requirements of the state board of health, the parent or  
7 guardian OF THE STUDENT or, IF THE STUDENT IS EMANCIPATED OR  
8 EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER, the ~~emancipated student or the~~  
9 ~~student eighteen years of age or older~~ shall submit to the school, within  
10 ~~fourteen~~ THIRTY days after receiving direct personal notification that the  
11 certificate is not up to date, documentation INDICATING that the next  
12 required immunization has been given and THAT INCLUDES a written plan  
13 for completion of all required immunizations. The scheduling of  
14 immunizations in the written plan shall follow medically recommended  
15 minimum intervals approved by the state board of health. If the student  
16 begins but does not continue or complete the written plan, ~~he or she~~ THE  
17 SCHOOL shall ~~be suspended or expelled~~ SUSPEND OR EXPEL THE STUDENT  
18 pursuant to this part 9."
