After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB25-1076 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 4, after line 12 insert:

2 "SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-2-136, add (6)(c)  
3 as follows:

4 **42-2-136. Unlawful possession or use of license.** (6) (c) A  
5 PERSON THAT VIOLATES THIS SECTION VIOLATES SECTION 18-5-121 AND,  
6 IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTY, IS SUBJECT TO THE PENALTIES OF  
7 SECTION 18-5-121 (6).

8 **SECTION 3.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-4-313, add (5) as  
9 follows:

10 **42-4-313. Penalties.** (5) A PERSON THAT VIOLATES THIS SECTION  
11 VIOLATES SECTION 18-5-121 AND, IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTY,  
12 IS SUBJECT TO THE PENALTIES OF SECTION 18-5-121 (6).

13 **SECTION 4.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-4-1208, amend  
14 (5) introductory portion as follows:

15 **42-4-1208. Reserved parking for persons with disabilities -**  
16 **applicability - rules.** (5) **Fraud and trafficking.** A person is subject to  
17 the penalties in ~~section~~ SECTIONS 42-4-1701 (4)(a)(X) AND **18-5-121 (6)**  
18 if the person:".

19 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

20 Page 8, after line 3 insert:

21 "SECTION 12. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-2-107, repeal  
22 (2)(b)(I)(B) as follows:

23 **42-2-107. Application for license or instruction permit -**  
24 **anatomical gifts - donations to Emily Keyes - John W. Buckner organ**

1 **and tissue donation awareness fund - legislative declaration - rules -**  
2 **annual report - repeal.** (2) (b) (I) In addition to the requirements of  
3 subsection (2)(a) of this section, an application must state that:

4 (B) ~~The applicant agrees, within thirty days after the date the~~  
5 ~~applicant became a resident, to register in Colorado any vehicle owned by~~  
6 ~~the applicant."~~.

7 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

8 Page 9, after line 11 insert:

9 "SECTION 14. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-2-114.5, **amend**  
10 (3) as follows:

11 **42-2-114.5. Fees for driver's licenses, identification cards, and**  
12 **related services - crediting to DRIVES account - fee setting**  
13 **procedures - rules.** (3) The department may raise or lower the fees listed  
14 in subsection (2) of this section, but the department shall not increase the  
15 fee by more than five percent per year. THE DEPARTMENT MAY ROUND A  
16 FEE INCREASE TO THE NEAREST DOLLAR."

17 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

18 Page 10, line 11, strike "ISSUED UNDER THIS PART 1".

19 Page 10, lines 12 and 13, strike "PART 3 OF THIS ARTICLE 2." and  
20 substitute "THIS TITLE 42."

21 Page 11, before line 1 insert:

22 "SECTION 17. In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 42-1-222  
23 as follows:

24 **42-1-222. Motor vehicle investigations unit.** (1) The department  
25 shall establish a motor vehicle investigations unit to investigate and  
26 prevent fraud concerning the use of ~~driver's licenses, identification cards,~~  
27 ~~motor vehicle titles and registrations, and other motor vehicle~~ OFFICIAL  
28 documents, AS DEFINED IN SECTION 18-5-121 (1)(b), issued by the  
29 department ~~Such~~ OR THE DEPARTMENT'S AGENTS. THE unit shall also  
30 assist victims of identity theft by means of such documents.

31 (2) THE MOTOR VEHICLE INVESTIGATIONS UNIT MAY CANCEL,  
32 DENY, OR DENY THE ISSUANCE OR REISSUANCE OF AN OFFICIAL DOCUMENT,  
33 AS DEFINED IN SECTION 18-5-121 (1)(b), UPON DETERMINING THAT THE  
34 PERSON WAS NOT ENTITLED TO THE ISSUANCE OF THE OFFICIAL DOCUMENT  
35 FOR:

1           (a) FAILURE TO GIVE THE REQUIRED OR CORRECT INFORMATION IN  
2 AN APPLICATION FOR THE OFFICIAL DOCUMENT OR FOR COMMITTING  
3 FRAUD IN MAKING THE APPLICATION OR IN SUBMITTING ANY PROOF FOR  
4 THE APPLICATION; OR  
5           (b) PERMITTING AN UNLAWFUL OR FRAUDULENT USE OF THE  
6 OFFICIAL DOCUMENT OR FOR BEING CONVICTED OF AN OFFENSE INVOLVING  
7 MISUSE OF THE OFFICIAL DOCUMENT.  
8           (3) IF THE MOTOR VEHICLE INVESTIGATIONS UNIT CANCELS,  
9 DENIES, OR DENIES THE ISSUANCE OR REISSUANCE OF AN OFFICIAL  
10 DOCUMENT, AS DEFINED IN SECTION 18-5-121 (1)(b), THE AFFECTED  
11 PERSON MAY REQUEST A HEARING PURSUANT TO SECTION 24-4-105."

12   Renumber succeeding section accordingly.
