After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB25-1189 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 3, line 8, strike "~~a sum equal to four~~ EIGHT" and
2 substitute "a sum equal to four".
- 3 Page 3, line 12, strike "~~four~~ EIGHT" and substitute "four".
- 4 Page 4, line 5, after the period add "THE DEPARTMENT MAY ROUND THE
5 FEE TO THE NEAREST DOLLAR."
- 6 Page 4, lines 12 and 13, strike "TO CHOOSE THE MONTH OF EXPIRATION."
7 and substitute "TO SELECT THE MONTH OF EXPIRATION DURING INITIAL
8 REGISTRATION OR REGISTRATION RENEWAL. THE REQUEST MUST BE MADE
9 ONLY ONE TIME IN THE TWELVE MONTHS AFTER THE TRANSACTION DATE."
- 10 Page 4, line 24, strike "approximates" and substitute "~~approximates~~ IS
11 NECESSARY TO RECOVER".
- 12 Page 4, line 25, strike "incurred, not to exceed five dollars," and substitute
13 "incurred ~~not to exceed five dollars,~~".
- 14 Page 5, line 1, after "department" insert "OR AUTHORIZED AGENT".
- 15 Strike pages 6 and 7.
- 16 Page 8, strike lines 1 through 21.
- 17 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
- 18 Page 8, line 23, strike "and (3)(a)".

1 Page 8, strike lines 25 through 27 and substitute "**of a salvage vehicle -**
2 **rules - definitions.** (2) ~~Any~~ IF THE TITLE OF A VEHICLE THAT WAS
3 REBUILT FROM SALVAGE DOES NOT HAVE THE "REBUILT FROM
4 SALVAGE" DISCLOSURE ON THE TITLE OR IF THE VEHICLE IS SUBJECT TO
5 MULTIPLE ASSIGNMENTS, A person ~~who~~ THAT sells a THE vehicle rebuilt
6 from salvage for the purpose of transferring ownership of such vehicle
7 shall:".

8 Page 9, strike lines 1 through 11.

9 Page 10, strike lines 18 through 26 and substitute "**applicability.**
10 (1) Section 42-1-210, Colorado Revised Statutes, as amended in section
11 1 of this act; section 42-6-107, Colorado Revised Statutes, as amended in
12 section 4 of this act; and section 42-6-206, Colorado Revised Statutes, as
13 amended in section 5 of this act, take effect July 1, 2027; and the
14 remainder of the act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the
15 expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general
16 assembly; except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section
17 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item,
18 section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section,
19 or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general
20 election to be held in November 2026 and, in such case, will take effect
21 on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor;
22 except that section 42-1-210, Colorado Revised Statutes, as amended in
23 section 1 of this act; section 42-6-107, Colorado Revised Statutes, as
24 amended in section 4 of this act; and section 42-6-206, Colorado Revised
25 Statutes, as amended in section 5 of this act, take effect July 1, 2027.".

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
