Page 4, line 5, after the period add "THE DEPARTMENT MAY ROUND THE FEE TO THE NEAREST DOLLAR.".
Page 4, lines 12 and 13, strike "TO CHOOSE THE MONTH OF EXPIRATION. and substitute "TO SELECT THE MONTH OF EXPIRATION DURING INITIAL REGISTRATION OR REGISTRATION RENEWAL. THE REQUEST MUST BE MADE ONLY ONE TIME IN THE TWELVE MONTHS AFTER THE TRANSACTION DATE."
Page 4, line 24, strike "approximates" and substitute "approximates In NECESSARY TO RECOVER".
Page 4, line 25, strike "incurred, not to exceed five dollars," and substitute "incurred not to exceed five dollars,".
Page 5, line 1, after "department" insert "OR AUTHORIZED AGENT".

Page 8, strike lines 1 through 21.
