- Page 6, strike lines 4 through 24 and substitute:
- 14 "(b) EVERY FIVE YEARS, UPDATE THE INFORMATION PROVIDED ON
- 15 THE DEPARTMENT'S WEBSITE PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (1)(a) OF THIS
- 16 SECTION WITH THE MOST RECENT INFORMATION ON THE HEALTH DANGERS

- 2 RESIDENTIAL PREMISES OR DWELLING UNIT AND TO MITIGATE ANY
- 3 NEGATIVE EFFECT OF THE PRESENCE OF MOLD.".
- 4 Reletter succeeding paragraph accordingly.
- 5 Page 10, line 10, strike "THE" and substitute "A SUMMARY OF THE".
- 6 Page 10, line 14, strike "PERFORMED;" and substitute "PERFORMED, IF THE
- 7 MOLD WAS NOT FULLY REMOVED OR IS LIKELY TO RETURN;".
- 8 Page 10, strike lines 15 through 19 and substitute:
- 9 "(III) THE WEBSITE ADDRESS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC
- 10 HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT'S WEBSITE THAT PROVIDES INFORMATION
- 11 ABOUT THE HEALTH EFFECTS OF MOLD IN INDOOR ENVIRONMENTS IN
- 12 ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 25-4-2604 (1)(a).".
- Page 1, line 103, strike "REGISTRATION" and substitute "EDUCATION".
