Committee on Education.
After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:
<u>SB25-027</u> be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on <u>Appropriations</u> with favorable recommendation:
Amend printed bill, page 3, line 11, after "membership -" add "fund -".
Page 4, line 11, strike "IMMIGRATION STATUS,".
Page 4, strike lines 13 through 27.
Strike pages 5 and 6.
Page 7, strike lines 1 through 14 and substitute:
"(4) (a) (I) The work group consists of the following nonvoting members:
(A) A REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC
SAFETY, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR;
(B) A REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE OFFICE, APPOINTED BY THE
GOVERNOR;
(C) A REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE OFFICE OF GUN VIOLENCE
PREVENTION CREATED IN SECTION 25-20.5-1202, APPOINTED BY THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND
ENVIRONMENT;
(D) THE COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, OR
THE COMMISSIONER'S DESIGNEE; AND
(E) A STUDENT WHO ATTENDS A COLORADO PUBLIC SCHOOL,
APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR;".
(II) THE WORK GROUP CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING VOTING
MEMBERS:  (A) A SCHOOL DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT WHO REPRESENTS
(11) IT DELICOL DISTRICT SOLDRINGENING WITO RESERVED

EITHER A RURAL OR SUBURBAN SCHOOL DISTRICT, APPOINTED BY THE

PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE;

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- (B) A SCHOOL PRINCIPAL, OR THE PRINCIPAL'S DESIGNEE, APPOINTED BY THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES;
- (C) TWO TEACHERS, ONE OF WHOM MUST REPRESENT AN URBAN SCHOOL DISTRICT, APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE, AND ONE OF WHOM MUST REPRESENT AN URBAN SCHOOL DISTRICT, APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES;
- (D) A SCHOOL NURSE OR PEDIATRICIAN, APPOINTED BY THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES;
- (E) TWO MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONALS, ONE OF WHOM MUST SPECIALIZE IN CHILD DEVELOPMENT OR TRAUMA-INFORMED CARE, APPOINTED BY THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE SENATE, AND ONE OF WHOM MUST SPECIALIZE IN BEHAVIORAL HEALTH, APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES;
- (F) A SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER OR LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT REPRESENTATIVE WITH EXPERIENCE IN RURAL OR URBAN SCHOOL SETTINGS, APPOINTED BY THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE SENATE;
- (G) A PROFESSIONAL EXPERT IN PUBLIC HEALTH OR SCHOOL SAFETY, APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE;
- 21 (H) A PARENT OF A STUDENT CURRENTLY ATTENDING A 22 COLORADO PUBLIC SCHOOL, APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE 23 OF REPRESENTATIVES; AND
  - (I) AN AT-LARGE MEMBER, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR.".
- 25 Page 7, strike lines 20 through 23 and substitute:
- "(d) A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS APPOINTED TO THE WORK
  GROUP CONSTITUTES A QUORUM. IF THE WORK GROUP IS UNABLE TO
  REACH A QUORUM DUE TO UNFORESEEN CIRCUMSTANCES, THE WORK
  GROUP MAY PROCEED WITH A REDUCED QUORUM OF NO FEWER THAN SIX
  VOTING MEMBERS.".
- 31 Page 9, after line 27 insert:
- "(8) THE OFFICE MAY SEEK, ACCEPT, AND EXPEND GIFTS, GRANTS,
  OR DONATIONS FROM PRIVATE OR PUBLIC SOURCES FOR THE PURPOSES OF
  THIS SECTION. THE OFFICE SHALL TRANSMIT ALL MONEY RECEIVED
  THROUGH GIFTS, GRANTS, OR DONATIONS TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO
  SHALL CREDIT THE MONEY TO THE TRAUMA-INFORMED PRACTICES FOR
  SCHOOL SAFETY DRILLS FUND CREATED IN SUBSECTION (9) OF THIS
  SECTION.
- 39 (9) The trauma-informed practices for school safety

- 1 DRILLS FUND IS CREATED IN THE STATE TREASURY. THE
- 2 TRAUMA-INFORMED PRACTICES FOR SCHOOL SAFETY DRILLS FUND
- 3 CONSISTS OF GIFTS, GRANTS, OR DONATIONS CREDITED TO THE FUND
- 4 PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (8) OF THIS SECTION AND ANY OTHER MONEY
- 5 THAT THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY MAY APPROPRIATE OR TRANSFER TO THE
- 6 FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT ALL INTEREST AND INCOME
- 7 DERIVED FROM THE DEPOSIT AND INVESTMENT OF MONEY IN THE
- 8 TRAUMA-INFORMED PRACTICES FOR SCHOOL SAFETY DRILLS FUND TO THE
- 9 FUND.".

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
