(g) Additionally, commencing July 1, 2026, and on a continuing basis thereafter, the institute, each school district for the school district as a whole and for each of the school district's schools that are not district charter schools, each board of cooperative services, and each charter school shall post on its website, in a downloadable format for free public access, information regarding revenue from private sources, including revenue that is received as a gift, grant, or donation. The information must be categorized by type of private source and amounts of revenue received from private sources may be reported in the aggregate by category. Private sources include individuals, corporations or other businesses, trusts, or estates.

SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in November 2026 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor."
