After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB25-193 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, strike line 3 and substitute "(1)(g)(II),
2 (1)(g)(III), (2)(a), and (7); and **add** (1)(g)(IV) as follows:".
- 3 Page 2, line 5, strike "(7) This" and substitute "(1) The commissioner
4 shall convene a primary care payment reform collaborative to:
- 5 (g) Develop recommendations to increase the use of alternative
6 payment models that are not paid on a fee-for-service or per-claim basis
7 to:
- 8 (II) Align primary care reimbursement by all consumers of
9 primary care; **and**
- 10 (III) Direct investment toward higher value primary care services
11 with an aim toward reducing health disparities; AND
- 12 (IV) ENSURE THE DEVELOPMENT AND CONSIDERATION OF
13 ALTERNATIVE PAYMENT MODELS THAT ARE RESPONSIVE TO THE NEEDS OF
14 PRIMARY CARE DELIVERY IN PEDIATRICS.
- 15 (2) The commissioner shall invite representatives from the
16 following to participate in the primary care payment reform collaborative:
- 17 (a) Health-care providers, including primary care providers AND
18 PEDIATRIC PRIMARY CARE PROVIDERS;
- 19 (7) This".

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
