


The Governor's **Behavioral Health** Task Force identified the six pillars needed for a strong behavioral health system in Colorado.



Breakout of Funding by Major Services (FY23)

Community Mental Health Centers -\$61 M

General Funds \$45.0M (73%)

Cash Funds \$5.5M (9%)

Federal Funds \$6.7M (11%)

Stimulus Federal Funds \$4.0M (7%) Crisis Administrative Service Organizations -\$39 M

General Funds \$25.7M (66%)

Cash Funds \$4.1M (11%)

Federal Funds \$5M (13%)

Stimulus Federal Funds \$4.0M (10%) Substance Use Managed Service Organization - \$112 M

General Funds \$30.3M (27%)

Cash Funds \$30.5M (27%)

Reappropriated Funds \$2.4M (2%)

Federal Funds \$34.5M (31%)

Stimulus Federal Funds \$14.2M (13%)



The BHASOs will:

Consolidate MSOs, ASOs, and services offered by CMHCs.

Provide a continuum of behavioral health safety net services and care coordination.

Help individuals and families connect to behavioral health care and ensure timely access to service.

Interface and align with the RAEs that manage services and provide care coordination for Medicaid members.



Overview of BHA Funding (FY24)

Total Funding (\$M)



Approximately ~\$600M budget in FY24.

BHA estimates administrative cost of about \$18M, which would account for only 3% of total costs.
