# An Act

HOUSE BILL 16-1177

CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF THE COUNCIL OF HIGHER EDUCATION REPRESENTATIVES.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 23-1-108.5, **amend** (3) (e) as follows:

**23-1-108.5. Duties and powers of the commission with regard to common course numbering system - repeal.** (3) (e) This subsection (3) is repealed, effective ~~July 1, 2016~~ SEPTEMBER 1, 2021. Prior to such repeal, the council of higher education representatives shall be reviewed as provided for in section 2-3-1203, C.R.S.

**SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, **repeal** (3) (cc) (III); and **add** (3) (hh.5) (II) as follows:

**2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees.** (3) The
