Bill Summary

Sunset Process - Health, Insurance, and Environment Committee. The bill continues the infection control advisory committee until July 1, 2021.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

1 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-3-602, **amend** (7)
2 (a) as follows:

3 **25-3-602. Health facility reports - repeal.** (7) (a) Subsections
4 (4), (5), and (6) of this section and this subsection (7) are repealed,
5 effective July 1, 2016 2021.

6 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, **repeal** (3)
7 (cc) (II); and **add** (3) (hh) as follows:

8 **2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees.** (3) The
9 following dates are the dates on which the statutory authorization for the
10 designated advisory committee is scheduled for repeal:

20 COMMITTEE'S FUNCTIONS, AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 25-3-602 (5) AND (6),
21 C.R.S.;

22 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
23 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
24 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
