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**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

101      **CONCERNING AN ALLOCATION OF MONEY FOR THE ADDRESS**  
102                    **CONFIDENTIALITY PROGRAM, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH,**  
103                    **MAKING AND REDUCING AN APPROPRIATION.**

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**Bill Summary**

**Joint Budget Committee.** The bill allocates \$100,000 annually from the victims assistance and law enforcement fund to the department of personnel for the address confidentiality program.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-506, **amend**  
3 (1) introductory portion; and **add** (1) (e) as follows:

4 **24-33.5-506. Victims assistance and law enforcement fund -**  
5 **creation.** (1) There is hereby created in the state treasury a fund to be  
6 known as the victims assistance and law enforcement fund, referred to in  
7 this section as the "fund". The state treasurer shall credit to the fund all  
8 ~~moneys~~ MONEY deposited with the state treasurer pursuant to section  
9 24-4.2-105 (1) and voluntary victim assistance payments from inmates  
10 pursuant to article 24 of title 17, C.R.S. The general assembly shall make  
11 annual appropriations of the ~~moneys~~ MONEY in the fund to the division:

12 (e) FOR ALLOCATION OF ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS TO  
13 THE DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL FOR EXPENSES OF THE "ADDRESS  
14 CONFIDENTIALITY PROGRAM ACT", PART 21 OF ARTICLE 30 OF THIS TITLE.

15 **SECTION 2. Appropriation - adjustments to 2016 long bill.**

16 (1) To implement this act, the general fund appropriation made in the  
17 annual general appropriation act for the 2016-17 state fiscal year to the  
18 department of personnel for the address confidentiality program is  
19 decreased by \$100,000.

20 (2) For the 2016-17 state fiscal year, \$100,000 is appropriated to  
21 the department of personnel. This appropriation is from the victims  
22 assistance and law enforcement fund created in section 24-33.5-506,  
23 C.R.S., pursuant to section 24-33.5-506 (1) (e), C.R.S. To implement this  
24 act, the department may use this appropriation for the address  
25 confidentiality program.

26 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,

- 1 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
- 2 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
