BILL TOPIC: PUC APPROVAL OF SECURITIES ONLY FOR GAS AND ELECTRIC

Summary of Legislation

This bill clarifies that only public electric and gas utilities are required to apply to the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) for approval to issue or assume securities.

Assessment

Currently, the PUC only receives applications for approval to issue or assume securities from public electric and gas utilities and this bill clarifies that no other utilities are subject to this requirement. The bill does not affect the revenue or expenditures for any agency of state or local government. As such, this bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on April 21, 2016.
