#### **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$268,562 federal Child Care Development Funds to the Department of Human Services for FY 2016-17. This provision also states that the appropriation is for the purchase of information technology services. In addition, the amendment appropriates \$268,562 reappropriated funds to the Governor's Office of Information Technology.
