**Summary of Legislation**

By no later than July 1, 2017, the bill requires the Colorado Department of Labor and Employment (CDLE) to review rules and regulations within the department that may impact the establishment or integration of pre-apprenticeship and apprenticeship programs into Colorado businesses. The department will prepare a report, which will include recommendations based on this review and allow a period for public comment. Finally, the CDLE will submit the final report and recommendations to the State Workforce Development Council to be included in their annual Colorado Talent report.

**State Expenditures**

For FY 2016-17 only, this bill requires the CDLE to study internal rules and regulations and create a report based on this review. This will increase workload for the department but can be accomplished within existing appropriations.

**Effective Date**

The bill takes effect August 10, 2016, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 11, 2016, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
