BILL TOPIC: REVISOR'S BILL

Summary of Legislation

This bill, *recommended by the Committee on Legal Services*, amends or repeals obsolete, unclear, or conflicting laws. The bill also clarifies statutory language, but does not change the intent or meaning of existing statute. The bill's appendix explains the reasons for each amendment.

Assessment

The bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact. The bill only makes technical changes to existing statute and does not impact the revenues or expenditures of any agency of state or local government.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on June 6, 2016, and took effect on that date, with the following exceptions:

- Section 57 does not take effect because House Bill 16-1408 became law;
- Section 123 takes effect on August 10, 2016, if no referendum petition is filed;
- Section 124 takes effect on July 1, 2016;
- Sections 125 and 126 take effect on August 10, 2016, if no referendum petition is filed; and
- Section 127 takes effect on August 10, 2016, if no referendum petition is filed.
