Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB16-1178 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 4, after line 2, insert:

2 **"SECTION 2. Appropriation - adjustments to 2016 long bill.**

3 (1) For the 2016-17 state fiscal year, \$619,026 is appropriated to the  
4 department of higher education. This appropriation is from the general  
5 fund. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation  
6 as follows:

7 (a) \$117,276 for use by the Colorado commission on higher  
8 education for need based grants; and

9 (b) \$501,750 for college opportunity fund program stipends for  
10 students attending state institutions.

11 (2) For the 2016-17 state fiscal year, \$501,750 is appropriated to  
12 the department of higher education. This appropriation is from  
13 reappropriated funds received from the college opportunity fund program  
14 stipends for students attending state institutions under paragraph (b) of  
15 subsection (1) of this section. To implement this act, the department may  
16 use this appropriation as follows:

9 (3) To implement this act, appropriations made in the annual  
10 general appropriation act for the 2016-17 state fiscal year to the  
11 department of higher education from the students' share of tuition are  
12 decreased by a total of \$3,028,610 as follows:

27 cash funds amount received by the department of higher education for the  
28 Trustees of the Colorado school of Mines from the students' share of  
29 tuition, which is included in the annual general appropriation act for the  
30 2016-17 state fiscal year for informational purposes only, will be  
31 decreased by \$75,660."

33 Page 1, line 102, strike "COLORADO." and substitute "COLORADO, AND,  
34 IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AND REDUCING AN  
35 APPROPRIATION."
