101 CONCERNING THE SALARY CATEGORIZATION OF LOCALLY ELECTED  
102 OFFICIALS IN LAKE COUNTY.

Bill Summary

The bill changes the salary categorization for locally elected officials in Lake county.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

1           **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 30-2-102, **amend**  
2 (1.5)(a)(IV)(A) and (1.5)(a)(IV)(B) as follows:

3           **30-2-102. Categorization of counties for fixing salaries of**  
4 **county officers - salary amounts - legislative declaration.** (1.5) (a) For  
5 the purpose of establishing the salaries of county officers whose terms of  
6 office begin on or after January 1, 2016:

7           (IV) (A) Category IV-A counties consist of the counties of Custer,  
8 Elbert, ~~Lake~~, Ouray, and Prowers;

9           (B) Category IV-B counties consist of the counties of Kit Carson,  
10 LAKE, Washington, and Yuma;

11           **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
12 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
13 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
