5	the purpose of establishing the salaries of county officers whose terms of
6	office begin on or after January 1, 2016:
7	(IV)(A) Category IV-A counties consist of the counties of Custer,
8	Elbert, <del>Lake,</del> Ouray, and Prowers;
9	(B) Category IV-B counties consist of the counties of Kit Carson,
10	LAKE, Washington, and Yuma;
11	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
12	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
13	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
