CONCERNING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF  
TRANSPORTATION.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1. Appropriation to the department of transportation for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016.** In Session Laws of Colorado 2016, section 2 of chapter 385, (HB 16-1405), **amend** Part XXI, and **add** (7), as follows:
