BILL TOPIC: NONSUBSTANTIVE RELOCATION COMMISSION ON FAMILY MEDICINE

Summary of Legislation

Recommended by the Statutory Revision Committee, this bill relocates laws governing the Commission on Family Medicine, an advisory body within the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing (HCPF), from Title 25 to Title 25.5 in the Colorado Revised Statutes. It also makes conforming amendments.

Assessment

Relocation of these statutes will have no impact on the expenditures or revenues of any state agency or local government, and, therefore, this bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 9, 2017, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 10, 2017, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
