**Summary of Legislation**

The Restorative Justice Coordinating Council was created by House Bill 07-1129 to provide assistance and education related to restorative justice programs. This bill allows members of the Restorative Justice Coordinating Council to be reimbursed for expenses.

**State Expenditures**

Beginning in FY 2017-18, the Judicial Department will expend up to \$10,000 in cash funds annually to reimburse costs for mileage and lodging for the members of the Restorative Justice Council. These expenses can be paid using existing appropriations, and no additional appropriation is required.

**Effective Date**

The bill takes effect August 9, 2017, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 10, 2017, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
