Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$70,264 cash funds from the Recycling Resources Economic Opportunity Fund to the Department of Public Health and Environment for FY 2017-18. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.8 FTE to implement the act. Amendment J.001 also adds a provision appropriating \$38,011 cash funds from the Recycling Resources Economic Opportunity Fund to the Office of the Governor for FY 2017-18. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Office will require an additional 0.4 FTE to implement the act.
