**Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill neither requires nor contains an appropriation clause for FY 2017-18.

**Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**L.002** Bill Sponsor amendment **L.002** (attached) strikes the House Finance Committee Report (dated April 26, 2017) and restores the introduced version of the bill and the fiscal impact of the bill as described in the original Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note dated April 24, 2017. **Regardless of whether the Committee adopts amendment L.002, the bill does not require an appropriation clause for FY 2017-18.**

*Future Fiscal Impact*

Although this bill would not require a General Fund appropriation for FY 2017-18, as amended by the House Finance Committee it is projected to require General Fund appropriations of \$118,402 in FY 2018-19 and \$160,966 in FY 2019-20.
