**BILL TOPIC: MARIJUANA USE AS A CONDITION OF BOND** 

#### **Summary of Legislation**

This bill prohibits a court from requiring, as a condition of any bond, that a person who possesses a valid registry identification card abstain from using medical marijuana.

#### **Assessment**

This bill is not expected to alter the process for setting bonds and is therefore assessed as having no fiscal impact.

#### **Effective Date**

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on April 6, 2017, and takes effect August 9, 2017, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
