BILL TOPIC: LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE FOR PERSONS WITH A MENTAL HEALTH

DISORDER IN THE JUSTICE SYSTEM

#### **Summary of Legislation**

This bill renames an existing oversight committee to the "Legislative Oversight Committee Concerning the Treatment of Persons with Mental Health Disorders in the Criminal and Juvenile Justice Systems" (committee). It makes corresponding changes to the task force and cash fund and updates statutory terminology to read "mental health disorder" rather than "mental illness." Finally, it clarifies that the committee report due each January 15 to the General Assembly continues indefinitely, removes obsolete statutory language, and corrects statutory references to the Office of Behavioral Health in the Department of Human Services.

#### **Assessment**

This bill does not alter the workload, revenue, or expenditures for any state agency and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

#### **Effective Date**

The bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on April 28, 2017.
