Summary of Legislation

Recommended by the Joint Budget Committee, this bill makes four General Fund transfers totaling \$10,000,000 to Tier 2 funded programs for FY 2017-18.

State Revenue

State transfers. This bill requires the following transfers from the General Fund on July 1, 2017:

- \$2,272,727 to the Forest Restoration and Wildfire Risk Mitigation Grant Program Cash Fund in the Department of Higher Education;
- \$4,090,909 to the Species Conservation Trust Fund in the Department of Natural Resources (DNR);
- \$2,452,193 to the Division of Parks and Recreation Aquatic Nuisance Species Fund in DNR; and
- \$1,184,171 to the Division of Wildlife Aquatic Nuisance Species Fund in DNR.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
