NOTE: This bill was not enacted into law; therefore, the impacts identified in this analysis do not take effect.

Summary of Legislation

This bill requires the Transportation Legislation Review Committee (TLRC) to study the costs, benefits, practicality, effects, and implementation of replacing the standard issue license plates for motor vehicles during the 2017 interim.

State Expenditures

In FY 2017-18, there will be a minimal workload increase for the Department of Revenue (DOR) to provide information to the TLRC as it studies the replacement of standard issue license plates; this workload can be accomplished within existing appropriations. The study will occur as part of the regularly scheduled committee meetings in the 2017 interim. As such, no additional resources are required for the legislative service agencies that staff the TLRC.

Effective Date

The bill was postponed indefinitely by the Legislative Council Committee on April 28, 2017.
