After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB17-031 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 2, strike lines 18 through 21.

2 Page 3, strike lines 1 through 16 and substitute:

3 "SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 17-1-113.9, **amend**  
4 (1) as follows:

5 **17-1-113.9. Use of administrative segregation for state inmates**  
6 **- reporting.** (1) NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 24-1-136 (11)(a)(I), on or  
7 before January 1, 2012, and each January 1 thereafter, the executive  
8 director shall provide a written report to the judiciary committees of the  
9 senate and house of representatives, or any successor committees,  
10 concerning the status of administrative segregation; reclassification  
11 efforts for offenders with mental illnesses or developmental disabilities,  
12 including duration of stay, reason for placement, and number and  
13 percentage discharged; and any internal reform efforts since July 1, 2011.

14 **SECTION 3.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 17-1-115.7, **amend**  
15 (2) as follows:

16 **17-1-115.7. Prevention of sexual assaults on youthful inmates**  
17 **- compliance with federal law - report - definitions.**

18 (2) NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 24-1-136 (11)(a)(I), on or before  
19 October 1, 2013, and on or before each October 1 thereafter, the  
20 department shall report to the judiciary committees of the house of  
21 representatives and senate, or any successor committees, concerning the  
22 implementation of the policies described in subsection (1) of this section  
23 within the youth offender system described in section 18-1.3-407.5.  
24 C.R.S."

1 Page 6, strike lines 25 through 27.

2 Page 7, strike lines 1 through 9 and substitute:

3           **"SECTION 12. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act  
4 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the  
5 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August  
6 9, 2017, if adjournment sine die is on May 10, 2017); except that, if a  
7 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the  
8 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act  
9 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect  
10 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in  
11 November 2018 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the  
12 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor."

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
