Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB17-1121 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend the Health, Insurance, and Environment Committee Report, dated
2 March 2, 2017, page 9, line 7, strike "SEPTEMBER 1, 2017," and substitute
3 "JULY 1, 2018,".

4 Strike "SEPTEMBER 1, 2017." and substitute "JULY 1, 2018." on: **Page 1**,
5 line 6; **Page 2**, line 18; **Page 3**, line 16; **Page 4**, line 16; **Page 7**, line 31;
6 **Page 9**, lines 1 and 2; and **Page 10**, line 34.

7 Page 12 of the report, after line 2 insert:

8 "Strike "SEPTEMBER 1, 2017," and substitute "JULY 1, 2018," on: **Page 3**
9 of the bill, line 7; **Page 5** of the bill, line 4; **Page 7** of the bill, line 2; **Page**
10 **10** of the bill, line 2; **Page 13** of the bill, line 26; **Page 18** of the bill, line
11 2; and **Page 20** of the bill, line 15."

12 Page 11 of the report, after line 29 insert:

13 "Page 52 of the printed bill, after line 13 insert:

14 **"SECTION 24. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2017-18 state fiscal
15 year, \$576,126 is appropriated to the department of public safety. This
16 appropriation is from the Colorado bureau of investigation identification
17 unit fund created in section 24-33.5-426, C.R.S. To implement this act,
18 the department may use this appropriation as follows:

1 (a) \$279,144 for use by the biometric identification and records
2 unit for criminal history record checks, which amount is based on an
3 assumption that the unit will require an additional 0.9 FTE; and

4 (b) \$296,982 for use by executive director's office for leased space.

5 (2) For the 2017-18 state fiscal year, \$50,000 is appropriated to
6 the department of regulatory agencies. This appropriation is from the
7 division of professions and occupations cash fund created in section
8 24-34-105 (2)(b)(I), C.R.S. To implement this act, the department may
9 use this appropriation for the purchase of information technology
10 services.

11 (3) For the 2017-18 state fiscal year, \$50,000 is appropriated to
12 the office of the governor for use by the office of information technology.
13 This appropriation is from reappropriated funds received from the
14 department of regulatory agencies under subsection (2) of this section. To
15 implement this act, the office may use this appropriation to provide
16 information technology services for the department of regulatory
17 agencies.".

18 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

19 Page 1 of the printed bill, line 106, strike "AND".

20 Page 1 of the printed bill, line 107, strike "COMPACT." and substitute
21 "COMPACT, AND, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.".

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
