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A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING AN EXTENSION OF THE OPERATION OF THE STATE
102 LOTTERY DIVISION BEYOND JULY 1, 2024.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill repeals the scheduled termination on July 1, 2024, of the state lottery division (division) in the department of revenue, the effect of which is to permanently establish the division.

1 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-35-218, **repeal**

2 (1)(a) as follows:

3 **24-35-218. Annual financial audits of the division.**

4 (1) (a) ~~Unless continued or reestablished by the general assembly acting~~
5 ~~by bill, the division shall terminate on July 1, 2024.~~

6 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-35-207, **amend**

7 (3) as follows:

8 **24-35-207. Colorado lottery commission - creation.** (3) Initial
9 members shall be appointed to the commission by the governor as
10 follows: One member to serve until July 1, 1983, one member to serve
11 until July 1, 1984, one member to serve until July 1, 1985, and two
12 members to serve until July 1, 1986. All subsequent appointments shall
13 be for terms of four years. ~~subject to continuation of the division pursuant~~
14 ~~to section 24-35-218.~~ No member of the commission shall be eligible to
15 serve more than two terms.

16 **SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
17 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
18 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
19 8, 2018, if adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2018); except that, if a
20 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
21 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
22 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
23 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
24 November 2018 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
25 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
