101 CONCERNING COVERED HEALTH CARE SERVICES PROVIDED BY A

Bill Summary

The bill requires a health benefit plan to provide coverage for health care services provided by a pharmacist if:

- ! The services are provided within a health professional shortage area; and
- ! The health benefit plan provides coverage for the same services provided by a licensed physician or advanced



practice nurse.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 10-16-144, add (2)
3 as follows:

10-16-144. Health care services provided by pharmacists.
(2) (a) A HEALTH BENEFIT PLAN DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS
SECTION SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR HEALTH CARE SERVICES
PROVIDED BY A PHARMACIST WITHIN A HEALTH PROFESSIONAL SHORTAGE
AREA, AS DEFINED IN 42 U.S.C. SEC. 254e, IF THE CONDITIONS SPECIFIED
IN SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION ARE MET.

10 (b) THIS SUBSECTION (2) DOES NOT REQUIRE A CARRIER TO
11 CONTRACT WITH A PHARMACY OR PHARMACIST WILLING TO ABIDE BY THE
12 TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION ESTABLISHED BY THE HEALTH
13 BENEFIT PLAN OR CARRIER.

14 SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 15 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 16 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 17 8, 2018, if adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2018); except that, if a 18 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 19 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 20 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect 21 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 22 November 2018 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 23 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
