CONCERNING PEACE OFFICER STATUS FOR THE ADMINISTRATOR OF JUDICIAL SECURITY IN THE COLORADO JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** 16-2.5-152 as follows:

16-2.5-152. Administrator of judicial security. AN ADMINISTRATOR OF JUDICIAL SECURITY EMPLOYED BY THE JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT IS A PEACE OFFICER WHOSE AUTHORITY INCLUDES THE ENFORCEMENT OF ALL LAWS OF THE STATE OF COLORADO, AND SUCH ADMINISTRATOR OF JUDICIAL SECURITY MUST BE CERTIFIED BY THE P.O.S.T. BOARD.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,

determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
