A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE BIENNIAL REGISTRATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITH
102 THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Current law authorizes the department of revenue (department) to register motor vehicles biennially. The bill requires the department to promulgate rules offering motor vehicle owners the option to register motor vehicles biennially.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-3-102, **amend** (1)
3 introductory portion, (1)(a), and (2)(a) as follows:

4 **42-3-102. Periodic registration - rules.** (1) The department may
5 establish by rule a periodic vehicle registration program whereby ~~certain~~
6 vehicles ~~shall be~~ ARE registered at:

7 (a) Subject to ~~the provisions of subsection~~ SUBSECTIONS (2) AND
8 (3) of this section, twelve-month intervals, in which case the registration
9 of ~~such~~ THE vehicles ~~shall expire~~ EXPIRES on the last day of the month of
10 each twelve-month registration period;

11 (2) (a) Except for motor vehicles of model year 1981 or older and
12 except for motorcycles of any model year, the department ~~may~~ SHALL
13 GIVE THE OWNER THE OPTION TO register A motor ~~vehicles at~~ VEHICLE FOR
14 A two-year ~~intervals~~ PERIOD upon payment of a two-year registration fee
15 and a two-year specific ownership tax. The owner of a motor vehicle ~~that~~
16 ~~is eligible as determined by the department for two-year registration~~ may
17 elect a two-year registration pursuant to UNDER this subsection (2), which
18 registration ~~shall expire~~ EXPIRES on the last day of the last month of each
19 two-year registration period.

20 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-3-201, **amend**
21 (1)(b)(I) as follows:

22 **42-3-201. Number plates furnished - style - periodic reissuance**
23 **- tabs - rules.** (1) (b) (I) The department may issue the number plates
24 required in this section for one or more registration periods. If the number
25 plates are issued for multi-year use, the department may issue a validating
26 tab or sticker to indicate the ~~year~~ EXPIRATION DATE of THE VEHICLE
27 registration. ~~of the vehicle.~~

1 **SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
2 takes effect January 1, 2019; except that, if a referendum petition is filed
3 pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this
4 act or an item, section, or part of this act within the ninety-day period
5 after final adjournment of the general assembly, then the act, item,
6 section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the
7 general election to be held in November 2018 and, in such case, will take
8 effect on January 1, 2019, or on the date of the official declaration of the
9 vote thereon by the governor, whichever is later.
