A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING OFFENSES AGAINST WITNESSES IN NONCRIMINAL**
102 **PROCEEDINGS.**

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill clarifies that the offenses of intimidating a witness or victim and retaliation against a witness or victim apply to witnesses in criminal, civil, and administrative proceedings.

1 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 18-8-704, **amend** (1)
2 introductory portion as follows:

3 **18-8-704. Intimidating a witness or victim.** (1) A person
4 commits intimidating a witness or victim if, by use of a threat, act of
5 harassment as defined in section 18-9-111, or act of harm or injury to any
6 person or property directed to or committed upon a witness ~~or~~ IN ANY
7 CRIMINAL OR CIVIL PROCEEDING; a victim ~~to~~ OF any crime; a person he or
8 she believes has been or is to be called or who would have been called to
9 testify as a witness IN ANY CRIMINAL OR CIVIL PROCEEDING or a victim OF
10 ANY CRIME; a member of the witness' family; a member of the victim's
11 family; a person in close relationship to the witness or victim; a person
12 residing in the same household with the witness or victim; or any person
13 who has reported a crime or who may be called to testify as a witness to
14 or victim of any crime, he or she intentionally attempts to or does:

15 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 18-8-706, **amend** (1)
16 as follows:

17 **18-8-706. Retaliation against a witness or victim.** (1) An
18 individual commits retaliation against a witness or victim if such person
19 uses a threat, act of harassment as defined in section 18-9-111, or act of
20 harm or injury upon any person or property, which action is directed to or
21 committed upon a witness ~~or~~ IN ANY CRIMINAL OR CIVIL PROCEEDING; a
22 victim ~~to~~ OF any crime; an individual whom the person believes has been
23 or would have been called to testify as a witness IN ANY CRIMINAL OR
24 CIVIL PROCEEDING or A victim OF ANY CRIME; a member of the witness'
25 family; a member of the victim's family; an individual in close
26 relationship to the witness or victim; an individual residing in the same
27 household with the witness or victim, as retaliation or retribution against

1 such witness or victim.

2 **SECTION 3. Effective date - applicability.** This act takes effect
3 July 1, 2018, and applies to offenses committed on or after said date.

4 **SECTION 4. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
5 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
6 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
